This is to Certify **Saponé Bathroom Modules**

Product Description

The certificate covers the design and manufacture of Saponé Bathroom Modules. This is referred to as the Saponé methodology.

Complies with the Building Code of New Zealand:

When designed, specified, manufactured and installed in accordance with the conditions of this certificate, the Saponé Bathroom Module (and the building elements that comprise it) will comply with or contribute to compliance with the following provisions of the NZBC:

B1 Structure – B1.3.1, B1.3.2, B1.3.3 (a), (b), (f), (j), B1.3.4

B2 Durability – B2.3.1 (b) or (c) as applicable, B2.3.2 (b)

C3 Fire Affecting Areas Beyond the Fire Source – C3.4 (a), (b)

E3 Internal Moisture – E3.3.1, E3.3.2, E3.3.3, E3.3.4, E3.3.5, E3.3.6

F2 Hazardous Building Materials – F2.3.1, F2.3.3

G1 Personal Hygiene – G1.3.2 (a), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g)

G2 Laundering – G2.3.2

G4 Ventilation – G4.3.3 (b), (c)

G5 Interior Environment – G5.3.1, G5.3.2

G9 Electricity – G9.3.1 (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), G9.3.3

G12 Water Supplies – G12.3.2 (a), (b), (c), G12.3.5 (b), G12.3.7 (a), (b), (c)

G13 Foul Water – G13.3.1 (a), (b), (c), (d)

And

C3.6 – For buildings where the Saponé Bathroom Module is incorporated into an intertenancy wall which is part of a relevant boundary for fire design.

And

G1.3.4, G6.3.2, G12.3.10 – For buildings for which facilities for persons with disabilities are required.

And

G6.3.1, G6.3.2 – For buildings where Saponé bathroom module directly adjoins the habitable space of another household unit.

Subject to the following conditions and limitations:

- The building in which the Saponé bathroom module is installed must provide the following connections for the Saponé bathroom module;
 - An electrical system that complies with the NZBC.
 - A potable water system that complies with the NZBC.
 - A tempered hot water system that complies with the NZBC.
 - Disposal of waste water and foul water that complies with the NZBC.
 - A ventilation system that complies with the NZBC.
- The Saponé bathroom module must be secured to the primary structure of the building as specified by the Saponé In Rebate and Saponé On Slab Installation Procedures v1.0.
- When this certificate forms part of a building consent application the building consent application must also include;
 - A CCLNZ Ltd Declaration that the design is in accordance with the Saponé methodology that is specified in this certificate, and
 - The CCLNZ pass™ v2.0 that identifies which code clauses apply to the specific building project, and
 - A requirement the CCLNZ Ltd will provide as part of the application for a Code Compliance Certificate;
 - A Manufacturing Declaration confirming that manufacture is in accordance with the Saponé methodology that is specified in this certificate and
 - A registered Electrician's Certificate of Compliance.
- Where the Saponé bathroom module forms part of an external wall, the additional building code provisions are outside the scope of this certificate.



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Product Use and Scope

The Saponé bathroom module is a fully finished, manufactured bathroom module for installation in any new or existing building.

Installation of the Saponé module entails securing the module to the primary structure of the building and connecting to the buildings electrical, fire safety, ventilation, potable water, tempered hot water and waste water and foul water disposal systems.
